Matthew 13:24-43

How much more power do you need? The parables of the weeds, mustard seed, and yeast.

The Kingdom of God

The kingdom is God's reign through God's people over God's place.

The Parable of the Weeds

- Evil is sown in the same soil as the good seed.
- When asked, "Should we destroy the weeds?" The answer is "No."
- The point of the parable is that God alone is the Judge.
- In the Kingdom, we replace power over others with trust in God.

The Parable of the Mustard Seed

- There is nothing glamorous about mustard seeds.
- The point is that true power is not obvious at first.
- We cannot trust our instinct to reveal the way of the Kingdom.
- In the Kingdom, we reject the sparkle of wealth and practice humility instead.

The Parable of the Yeast

- Yeast takes time to work.
- A little yeast, a lot of change.
- What would happen if we all discipled twelve people during our lifetime?
- The point is that God works in ways we would never think to.
- The Kingdom trusts small efforts to bring dramatic change.
